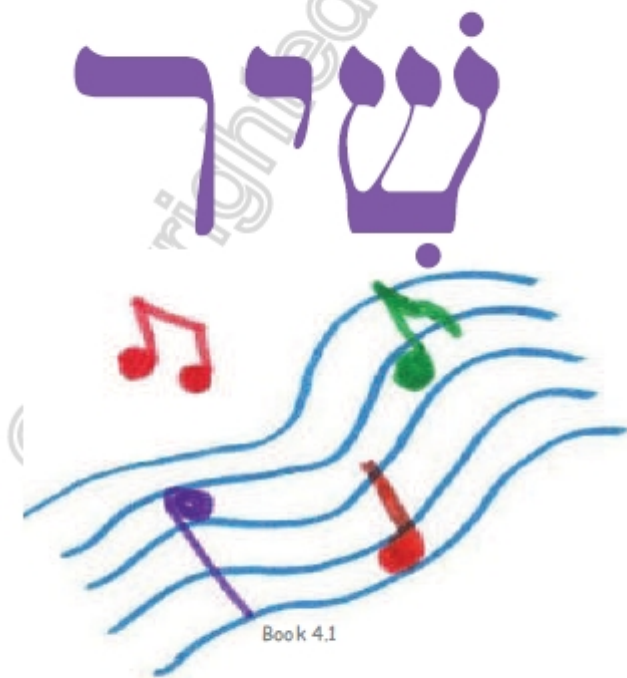


I'm glad you've come! It's time

It's just two letters and some dots.

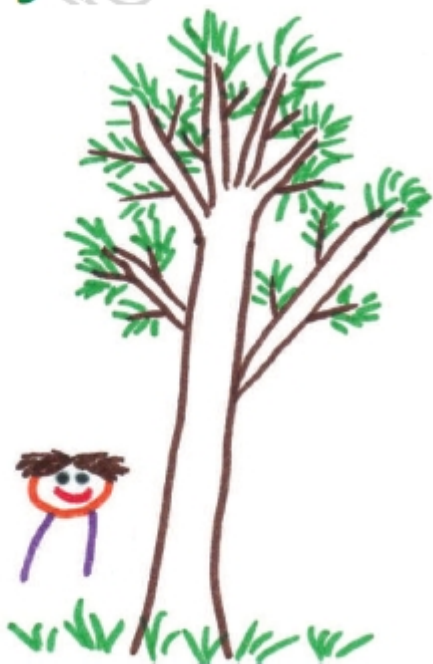
This is the word for tree.
