A Note to Parents

The following workbook pages are designed to be used with *Biblical Greek for Children*. Each reader within that series will find corresponding workbook pages in this volume. (Please note that Book Six of levels 2-5 are review lessons; these readers therefore have no corresponding workbook pages. Use the extra time provided in this case to review all material covered in each level.)

Each book of the five levels of *Biblical Greek for Children* are supplied with four workbook pages. However, because of the necessity of laying a firm foundation on the Greek alphabet, extra pages are added for the six books of Level One. Use these extra exercises as needed to assist child in letter recognition and pronunciation.

As stated in the Teacher's Guide, the memorization of letter *names* is not necessary for young children. Several exercises that focus on name acquisition are included in this workbook, but are optional. If your child is not learning letter names, simply skip these exercises.

The reverse of each page has been left blank. If child is experiencing difficulty with any particular concept, use this blank space to write out extra exercises taken either from the corresponding readers or tests provided in the Teacher's Guide. For older children, this extra space can be employed by having child write phrases and sentences in Greek using the new concepts acquired in the Greek readers.
